

Business Minors and Concentrations

FOR STUDENTS NOT MAJORING IN BUSINESS

- **Minor in Business:** 18 credits consisting of BUS 109 and BUS 209.

FOR MAJORS IN THE BYRUM SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

- **Minor in Accounting:** 24 credits beyond BUS 109 including BUS 209, ACC 250, 310, FIN 111 and 6 credits of electives from ACC 320, 321, 430, 431, 440, 455, FIN 311, MIS 320.
- **Minor in Finance:** 24 credits beyond BUS 109 including BUS 209, FIN 111 311, ACC 250 and 6 credits of electives from FIN 350, 352, 358, 360, 411, 455, ACC 430, MIS 320.
- **Business in Sports Concentration:** 18 credits beyond BUS 109 including BUS 209 and 9 credits from MGT 311(FA), MKT 348(FA), MGT 358(FA), PSY 340(FA), second internship in field, with School of Business approval.
- **Entrepreneurship Concentration:** 18 credits beyond BUS 109 including BUS 209, 262(SCR) and 6 credits from MKT 344(SCR), MGT 358(FA), MGT 372(SCR), FIN 111(SEM), ACC 250(SCR), second internship in field, with School of Business approval.
- **Human Resource Management Concentration:** 18 credits beyond BUS 109 including BUS 209 and 9 credits from MGT 351(FA), 352(SCR), 358(FA), 361(FA), 362(SCR), 363(SCR), second internship in field, with School of Business approval.
- **Insurance:** 18 credits beyond BUS109 including BUS209, FIN357 and 6 credits from the following: FIN 360(FAL), MKT 342(SCR), second internship in field with School of Business approval.
- **Integrated Marketing Communications:** 18 credits beyond BUS109 including BUS209 and 9 credits from the following: ART 229(FAL), MKT 217(SCR), 317(ADD), 341(FAL), 366 (FAL), COM 365 (SCR), MKT 445(SCR), second internship in field with School of Business approval.
- **Management Information Systems Concentration:** 18 credits beyond BUS 109 including BUS 209 and 9 credits from MIS 290(2SE), 310(2SE), 320(FA), 330(SCR), second internship in field, with School of Business approval.
- **Professional Selling:** 18 credits beyond BUS 109 including BUS 209, MKT 342(FAL) and 6 credits from MKT 341(FAL), 442(FAL), 444(SCR), second internship in field, with School of Business approval.

Courses cannot double count for minors, concentrations and/or majors with the exception of a second internship. A second internship satisfies the core requirement for Elective Business Experience. If the tasks associated with a second internship are specific to a concentration, then a second internship can double count toward the concentration.
